A work planner inspected our electric line right of way and the results of the inspection show:

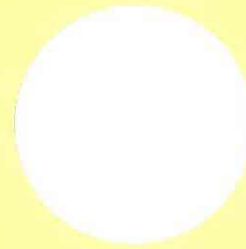
- Trimming is required (painted "dot" on base of tree)

All removed brush and tree branches smaller than 4" in diameter shall be chipped and removed from the site. All timber larger than 4" in diameter shall be cut into handling lengths and stacked nearby. \* All work done at no cost to the property owner.
